

SUMMARY OF INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBCONTRACTORS:

The certificate of insurance issued on behalf of [subcontractor's name], naming 1996 LLC dba: Chambers Construction as certificate holder, will need the following items submitted to meet the insurance requirements:

| Certificate Holder, owners, directors, and officers must be listed as Additional Insured. | |
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| A copy of the Additional Insured Clause included in the policy or added by endorsement must be attached to the certificate and include Products/Completed Operations wording. | |
| Workers Compensation, as required by law. | |
| General Liability Limits including Premises Ops and Products/Completed Operations must be equal to or greater than \$2,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate. These limits may be satisfied by a single primary policy or a combination of a primary policy with excess liability or umbrella policy. | |
| Auto Liability limits must be equal or greater than \$2,000,000 for bodily injury and property damage liability. These limits may be satisfied by a single primary policy or a combination of a primary policy with excess liability or umbrella policy. | |
| Primary and Non-Contributory wording must be shown on the certificate. | |
| 30 Day Notice of Cancellation, except 10 days for nonpayment of premium is required. | |
